RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the Town Council:

1. Accept the work completed as part of the Ramona Road Widening and Rancho Verde Elementary School Safe Routes to School, et al – Project No. 2014-04, for a total cost of \$1,477,069.61.
2. Direct the Town Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for the contract work.
3. Direct the Finance Director to release the retained funds thirty (30) days after the Notice of Completion has been filed, provided no claims are filed against the contractor.

SUMMARY:

On May 10, 2016, the Town awarded a contract to Vance Corporation for the Ramona Road Widening and Rancho Verde Elementary School Safe Routes to School, et al project. This project included providing necessary labor, equipment and materials to widen and install Class II bike lanes along Ramona Road from Navajo to Central and install new curb, gutter and sidewalk on Pioneer Road from Ramona to the southern property line of Rancho Verde Elementary School. In addition, the contractor constructed a bus turnout located on Central Road north of Bear Valley Road. Lastly, Vance

Corporation constructed an overlay on Apple Valley Road from Bear Valley to Town Center Drive.

FISCAL IMPACT:

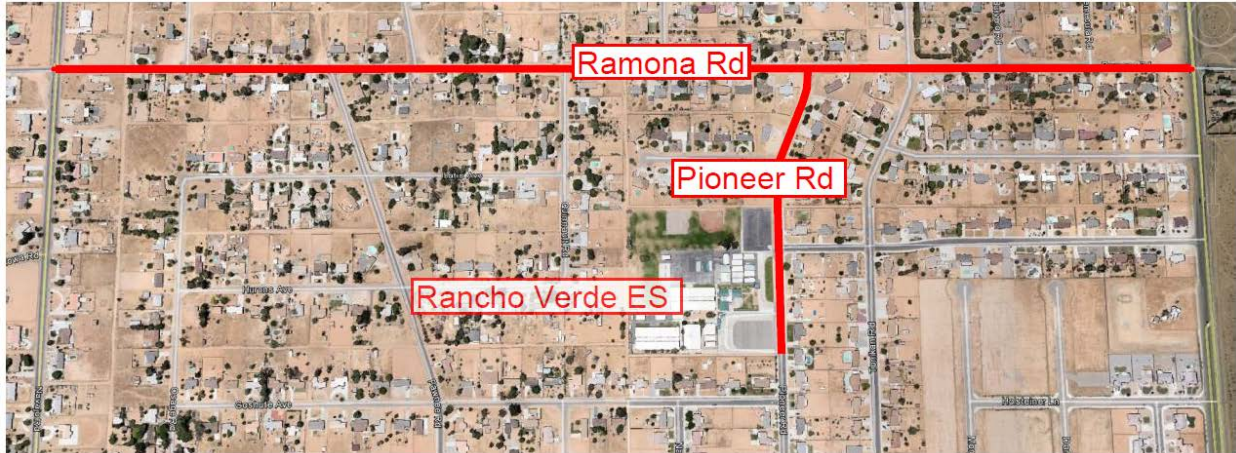
The final cost for this project is \$1,477,069.61, and the project was completed within budget. There is no additional fiscal impact.
