Subject Item:

REVIEW AND APPROVE CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CORWIN ROAD STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO PROCEED WITH ADVERTISEMENT FOR THIS PROJECT.

Summary Statement:

The Corwin Road Street Improvement Project is a four-mile project spanning from Highway 18 to Ramona Road (Apple Valley Airport). The project has been split into three segments due to varying types of improvements that will take place. The first segment, from Highway 18 to Choco Road, will receive a full reconstruction, widening to three lanes, and class II bike lanes. The second segment, from Choco Road to Waalew Road, will receive a full reconstruction, class II bike lanes and a new right-turn pocket for northbound traffic turning right from Corwin Road onto Waalew Road. The third segment of this project, from Waalew Road to Ramona Road, will receive an asphalt overlay. Once this project is completed, the new center turn lane will significantly improve the safety for residents pulling into and out of their driveways along Corwin Road. Further, the new class II bike lanes will add nearly three miles of bike lanes for the benefit of all residents.

Staff has reviewed the plans for this project and is satisfied that the specifications meet the intent of the Town Council for this project. The specifications, with bid packet, are being brought to the Town Council for review, approval and authorization to proceed prior to the bid opening. Staff recommends that the Town Council review the specifications and bid packet that are available in the Town Council office; approve the specifications and direct staff to proceed with the project.

Recommended Action:

Review and approve specifications for the Corwin Road Street Improvement Project and direct staff to proceed with the project.
