**AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE HIGHWAY 18 MEDIAN IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT 2010-01: NAVAJO ROAD TO PAWNEE ROAD**

Summary Statement:

On September 2, 2010, the Town received and opened bids for the subject contract to provide necessary labor, equipment and materials to install asphalt pavement, aggregate base, curb and gutter median, landscaping and irrigation lines, signing and striping on Highway 18 between Navajo Road and Pawnee Road. The bid results are as follows:

Cooley Construction Inc.	\$298,557
B & T Works, Inc.	\$312,807
Mega-Way Enterprises, Inc.	\$364,560
Sully-Miller Contracting Co.	\$439,385

Staff is satisfied that Cooley Construction Inc. is a responsible contractor for this work. The Highway 18 Median Project is programmed for construction over a period of 4-5 years due to budgetary constraints. The Phases/Segments are as follows:

1. Navajo Road to Pawnee Road
2. Tonikan Road to Central Road
3. Pawnee Road to Quinnault Road
4. Quinnault Road to Tonikan Road

Recommended Action:

Award a contract to Cooley Construction Inc., in the amount of \$298,557 for the Highway 18 Median Project, subject to "Approval as to Form" by the Town Attorney and "Approval as to Content" by the Town Manager;

This project was approved as a jointly funded project utilizing the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), A/C#2120-4210-7430-1600 and the Apple Valley Village Property Owners Business Improvement District (PBID) funds, A/C#8110-4210-9416-0000. Together, these two funds will allocate approximately \$300,000 per phase. As mentioned previously, the construction of the mile long median will be spread out over 4-5 years due to the annual availability of both the CDBG funds and PBID funds.
