A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) FOR 5 YEARS FOR CALRECYCLE GRANTS.

SUMMARY STATEMENT

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) administers a tire grant program to divert waste tires from landfills, prevent illegal dumping, educate the public on proper tire maintenance and disposal, and promote markets for recycled-content waste tire products.

CalRecycle has allocated \$1,100,000 for Waste Tire Amnesty Events for use in FY 2011/2012. CalRecycle will award grants on a competitive basis, and funds are available for jurisdictions to hold Tire Amnesty Day events.

The Town of Apple Valley Code Enforcement Department wishes to continue to sponsor annual Waste Tire Amnesty Day events, in an effort to reduce illegal dumping of tires in the desert. By virtue of previous grants, the Town of Apple Valley has been able to conduct an average of four Tire Amnesty Day events per year, which have resulted in the collection of 50,716 tires.

Recommended Action:

Adopt Resolution 2011-02, a Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley Authorizing the Town Manager to Execute Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) Grants on Behalf of the Town of Apple Valley.

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) GRANTS ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF APPLE VALLEY

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority the CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley authorizes the submittal of an application to CalRecycle for all grants for which the Town of Apple Valley is eligible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager, or his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Town of Apple Valley all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for five years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
